

St Mary of the Mills
Mass Intention Guidelines
As of September 17, 2021

The practice of requesting a Mass to be offered for loved ones, living or deceased, is a beautiful part of our Catholic Tradition. In order to accommodate the many requests for Mass intentions, in accord with Canon Law and Diocesan policy, the following are the St. Mary of the Mills guidelines:

- A request may be made for a deceased person, a living person who is sick, a living person celebrating a birthday or anniversary, in thanksgiving, or an intention fitting to the Eucharistic celebration. (Vocations, world peace, etc.)
- Requests for Mass Intentions will be honored on a first come, first served basis.
- Mass intentions can be scheduled up to one year in advance.
- A maximum of 5 single Mass intentions can be requested for any one intention for a given year.
- Each family/group is limited to 10 total Mass Intention requests per calendar year. Of those, only 5 may be Saturday vigil/Sunday Masses.
- Each weekend one Mass must be offered for All Parishioners.
- No Mass intentions are booked Holy Thursday, Good Friday or Holy Saturday. No daily Mass intentions are booked in November which is reserved for All Souls.
- Suggested offering/donation is \$10 per intention.
- Every effort will be made to publish the desired Mass intention in the current bulletin and mentioned at the Mass.
- The person requesting a Mass intention may receive a card that they can send to notify that the Mass intention has been offered.
